Scope of work: (Description of services, activities, or outputs)	 Specific Tasks for the Photographer Visit the places identified by the GCC office Communication Focal Point to capture necessary photographs and video clips. Focus on capturing images and short video clips in popular locations with various target groups, including youth, women, older persons and vulnerable groups with respect to their cultural and religious beliefs after gaining written permission . The selected locations should represent UNFPA's work, that showcase community development, health service provisions focusing on Reproductive health, youth and women, older persons and other empowerment programs that align with UNFPA's mandate emphasizing diversity and inclusivity and fulfilled lives. 	

	The photographer must obtain the required consent through UNFPA consent forms provided in line with UNFPA guidelines.
	The photographer may also be asked to suggest and identify some additional locations
	 The photographer has to ensure to ask permission from individuals before photographing them, and to make sure to obtain the required consent through consent forms.

	All pictures should be in High Resolution format as well as relate to areas where UNFPA works in GCC countries.
	Photos and video clips should pass professional editing standards. Captions must include detailed information including location, and date etc.
